**World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation:** Theme: "Hope and Act with Creation". The theme is drawn from St. Paul's Letter to the Romans (8: 19-25) where St. Paul explains what it means for us to live according to the spirit and focusses on the sure hope of salvation that is born of faith, namely, newness of life in Christ. "To hope and act with creation, then, means to live an incarnational faith, one that can enter into the suffering and hope-filled "flesh" of others, by sharing in the expectation of the bodily resurrection to which believers are predestined in Christ the Lord.
